## Personal data we process

Stichting Cyber Chain Resilience Consortium processes your personal data because you use our services and/or because you provide this data to us yourself.

Below is an overview of the personal data we process:

- First and last name
- Address details
- Phone number
- Email address

## Special and/or sensitive personal data we process

Our website and/or service does not intend to collect data about website visitors who are younger than 16, unless they have permission from a parent or guardian. However, we cannot verify whether a visitor is older than 16. We therefore advise parents to be involved in their children's online activities, in order to prevent data about children being collected without parental consent. ## For what purpose and on what basis we process personal data

Stichting Cyber Chain Resilience Consortium processes your personal data for the following purposes:

- Handling your payment
- Sending our newsletter and/or promotional materials
- Being able to call or email you if necessary to carry out our services
- Informing you about changes to our services and products
- Offering you the option to create an account

## Automated decision-making

Stichting Cyber Chain Resilience Consortium does not use systems that make decisions, based on automated processing, about matters that may have (significant) consequences for individuals. This concerns decisions made by computer programs or systems without human involvement (for example, an employee of Stichting Cyber Chain Resilience Consortium).

### **How long we retain personal data**

Stichting Cyber Chain Resilience Consortium does not retain your personal data longer than is strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which your data is collected. We apply the following retention periods for the following (categories of) personal data:

We retain contact details for as long as the person is a participant of CCRC. After participation ends, we retain the personal data for a maximum of 1 year.

### **Sharing personal data with third parties**

Stichting Cyber Chain Resilience Consortium only shares data with third parties if this is necessary for the execution of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation.

### **Cookies, or similar techniques, that we use**

Stichting Cyber Chain Resilience Consortium only uses technical and functional cookies, as well as analytical cookies that do not infringe on your privacy. A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer, tablet, or smartphone the first time you visit this website. The cookies we use are necessary for the technical functioning of the website and your ease of use. They ensure that the website works properly and remember, for example, your preferred settings. They also allow us to optimize our website. You can opt out of cookies by setting your internet browser so that it no longer stores cookies. You can also delete any information previously stored via your browser settings.

### **Accessing, modifying, or deleting data**

You have the right to access, correct, or delete your personal data. You also have the right to withdraw any consent you have given for data processing, or to object to the processing of your personal data by Stichting Cyber Chain Resilience Consortium, and you have the right to data portability. This means you can submit a request to us to send the personal data we hold about you to you or another organization of your choice in a computer file.

You can send a request for access, correction, deletion, or data transfer of your personal data, or a request to withdraw your consent or to object to the processing of your personal data, to [info@ccrc.nl](mailto:info@ccrc.nl).

To make sure the request for access has been made by you, we ask you to enclose a copy of your identity document with the request. In this copy, please black out your passport photo, MRZ (machine-readable zone, the strip of numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number, and Citizen Service Number (BSN). This is to protect your privacy. We will respond to your request as quickly as possible, but in any case within four weeks.

Stichting Cyber Chain Resilience Consortium would also like to point out that you have the option to file a complaint with the national supervisory authority, the Dutch Data Protection
